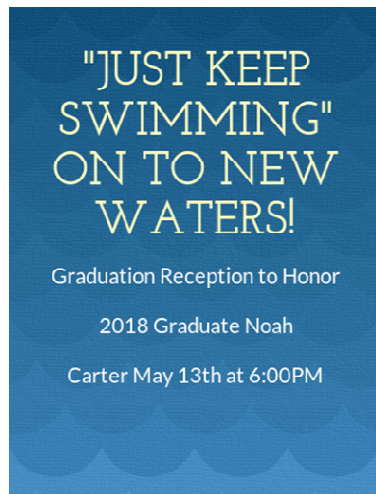


May 13 Happy Mother's Day
